## What is OSCA- Clinical Skills Workshops?

It has been identified that non-medical, pre-registration learners and post-registration professionals are required to achieve a range of proficiencies and competencies across disciplines and fields.

Using simulation as a learning and assessment strategy, OSCA- Workshops offers participants an opportunity to experience and practise the realities of professional practice and they can book at a time convenient to them to attend a theoretical session, with the opportunity to practice the skill and be formatively assessed.

## OSCA- Clinical Skills Workshops aims:



Increase opportunities for participants to consolidate and build confidence and skills



Increase access to simulated learner opportunities to maintain / progress clinical skills and knowledge



Increase networking opportunities



Development of effective compassionate, communication skills, team working and leadership skills to improve patient experience

**Breaking down OSCA- Clinical Skills Workshop:**

• **OUTREACH**

Outreach Skills Clinics for Assessment (OSCA) provides clinics at a range of sites across Cheshire and Merseyside. This being to offer flexibility to participants so they can book when and where they choose to access OSCA workshops.

• **SKILLS**

OSCA provides opportunities for participants to engage in theoretical and simulated practice learning opportunities to support learning and assessment across a range of clinical learning skills. These include: cannulation, venepuncture and catheterisation.

• **CLINIC**

OSCA-enables participants to access a range of sessions that they can attend by using an online booking system. Participants have the opportunity to book theoretical and practice learning opportunities which can fit around their work and life commitments.

• **ASSESSMENT**

During the sessions, participants will have the opportunity to book and complete a formative assessment, regarding a specific skill. On successful completion of the formative assessment, participants receive a certificate to utilise as part of their CPD portfolio.


